

A Study on Innovative Development of College English Education from the Perspective of New Media

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Abstract: In the era of new media, many emerging technologies and devices are constantly being applied in English education in universities, and have shown good teaching effects. During this process, students can use mobile phones and other devices to record and edit the content. In the classroom, they can share their practical content through group reports, which helps to exercise their English language expression ability and improve their comprehensive learning ability [6].
